ID Requirements: All students attending a U.S. Coast Guard approved course are now Required to provide the instructor with a picture ID on the first day of class. (Drivers License, MMD, Passport, Military ID, etc.)

Practical pool sessions – CLEAN work clothes and a towel.
All participants need to bring a extra set of coveralls/or standard work clothes that you would wear offshore for the pool/practical sessions.
***NO SWIM SUITS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE POOL.**
